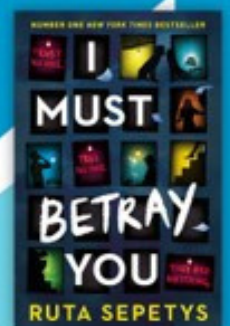
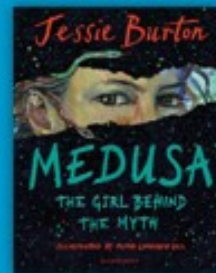

If you are up to the challenge of reading 7 books before 16th June, call in to see Mrs Thompson in the library. Shadowing starts Friday 31st March

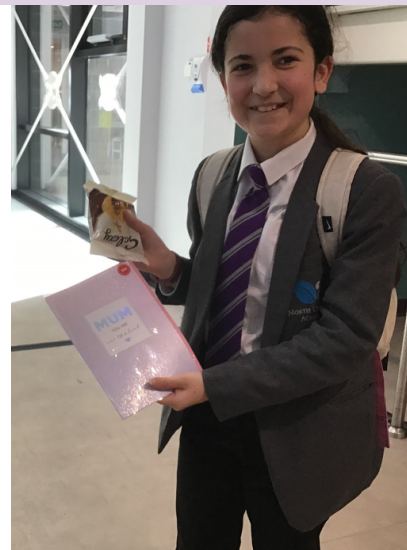
ROSEBERRY PRIMARY SCHOOL

READING





Our new paired reading group started this week – the students were totally engaged and reading in the library. It was wonderful to see!




The students who have demonstrated the most progress in their STAR reading tests in years 7,8 and 9 will receive Easter eggs for being egg-ceptional readers!
