Passport to Prom

Monday 11th September 2023 - Monday 6th May 2024

Criteria for admission to the Prom, students must:

- Attend an average of 3 GER after school revision sessions each week
- Have an attendance of 95% or above between the 11th September 2023 until Monday 6th May 2024, or have significantly improved attendance. Valid medical reasons for poor attendance will be discussed and admission to the prom will be at the discretion of the Year Team.
- Have a 90% positive merit ratio on Class Charts
- Demonstrate exemplary behaviour and effort in lessons and GER sessions.
